Further to our letter to you of 17 March 2013 regarding local content conditions, Santos GLNG is aware that Queensland Government will shortly approve the new QRC Resource and Energy Sector Code of Practice for Local Content. As such, Santos GLNG is seeking a project change to have "condition 15 —Local industry and participation program" withdrawn from the Project's conditions.

This change will maintain consistency with Government policy as well as being consistent with practices of other resource and energy proponents who are seeking a similar change from the Coordinator-General. It will also make reporting arrangements more efficient and effective with one reporting arrangement through QRC.
