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

Background

The *Queensland Curtis LNG project – Coordinator-General’s evaluation report for an environmental impact statement* (Coordinator-General’s report) was released in June 2010, pursuant to section 35 of the *State Development and Public Works Organisation Act 1971* (Qld) (SDPWO Act).

On 7 February 2014, the proponent applied to the Coordinator-General to evaluate proposed changes to the Queensland Curtis LNG (QCLNG) project, under Division 3A, section 35C of the SDPWO Act (the Act). In accordance with section 35H of the Act, the Coordinator-General has evaluated the environmental effects of these proposed changes, their effect on the project and any other related matters, and prepared this Coordinator-General’s change report under section 35I of the SDPWO Act.
