9. Use and Disclosure of Information Statement

However, information will not be made publicly available on the department website to the extent that it is provided by an owner of land (as defined in schedule 1 to the RPI Act) (an *owner*) who is not the applicant, and is commercial-in-confidence or personal information, and that owner has not consented to its disclosure, or to the extent that it is information which is considered to be sensitive security information.

Where an application proposes a resource or regulated activity in a priority agricultural area (PAA) and the applicant is required to provide information about the productive capacity or operation of a priority agricultural land use to address the prescribed solutions in the Regional Planning Interests Regulation 2014 (Schedule 2, Part 2), the information is to be provided in a separate document. The applicant may also be required to publicly notify the application. A notice about the chief executive's decision relating to the application will also be publicly notified.

The personal details of applicants will not be disclosed for a purpose outside this assessment process, except where required by legislation (including the *Right to Information Act 2009*). This information may be stored in a database by the department.

The information collected will be retained as required by the Public Records Act 2002.
